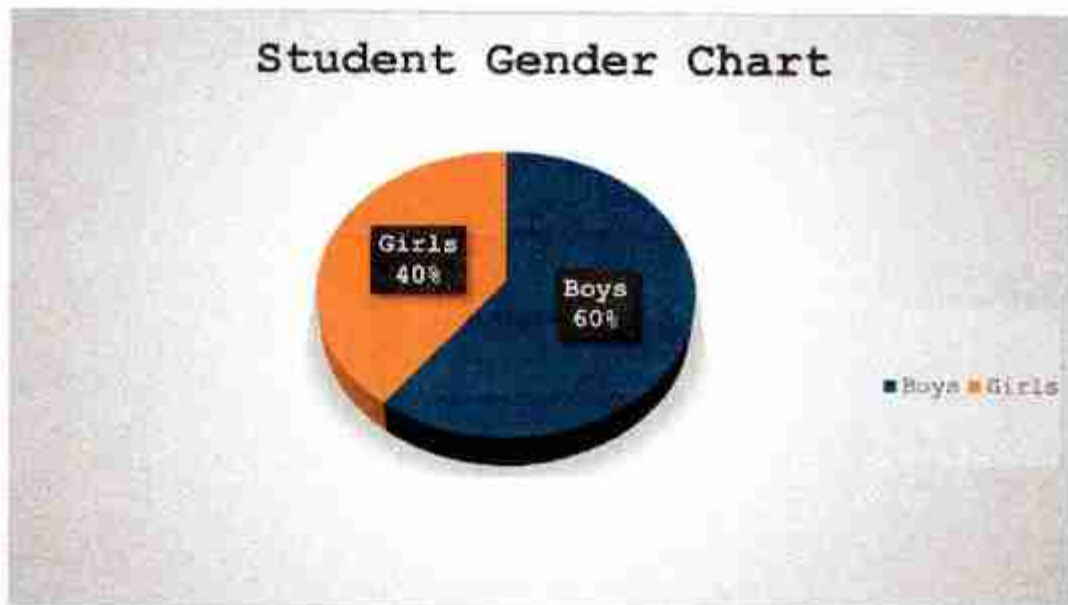

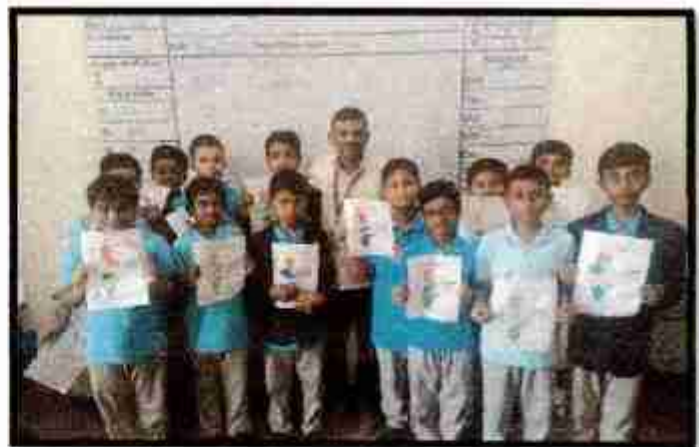
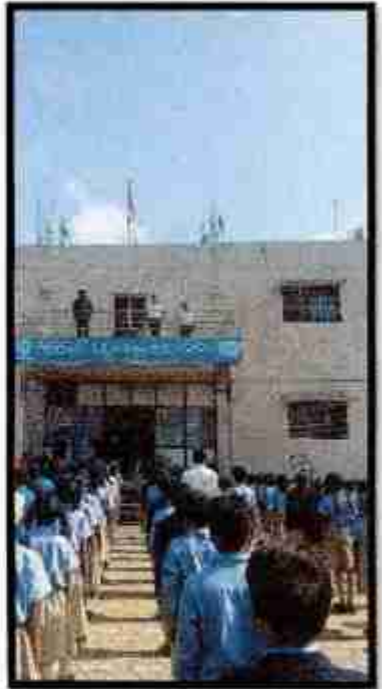
## **Pre-Independence Day Celebration**

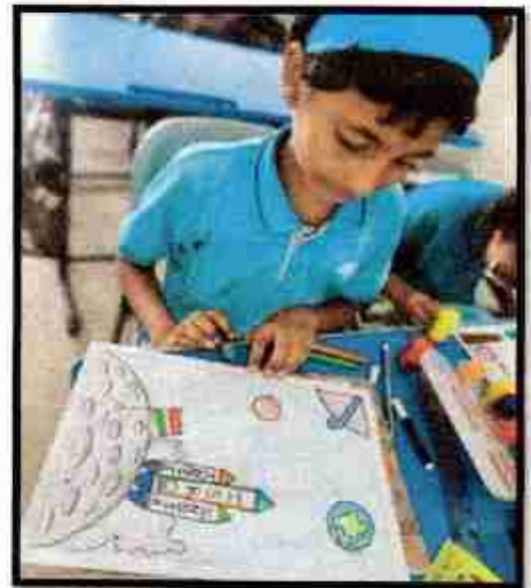


## **National Space Day**

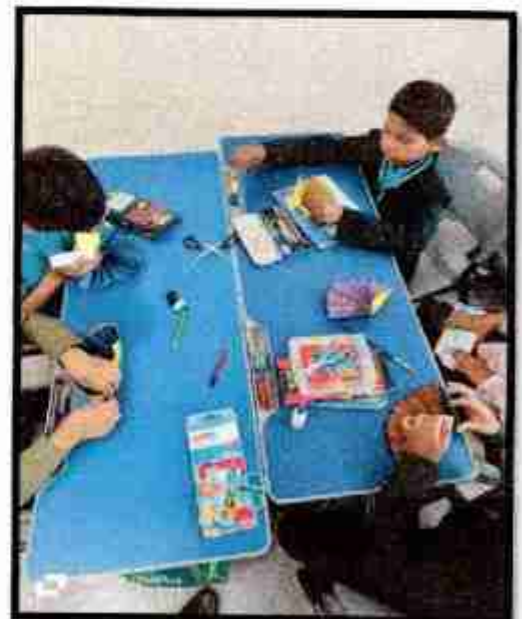
### **Celebration of Gandhi Jayanti**

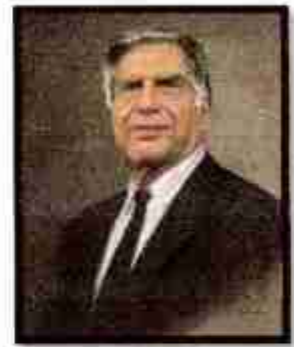
### **Celebration of Constitution Day**

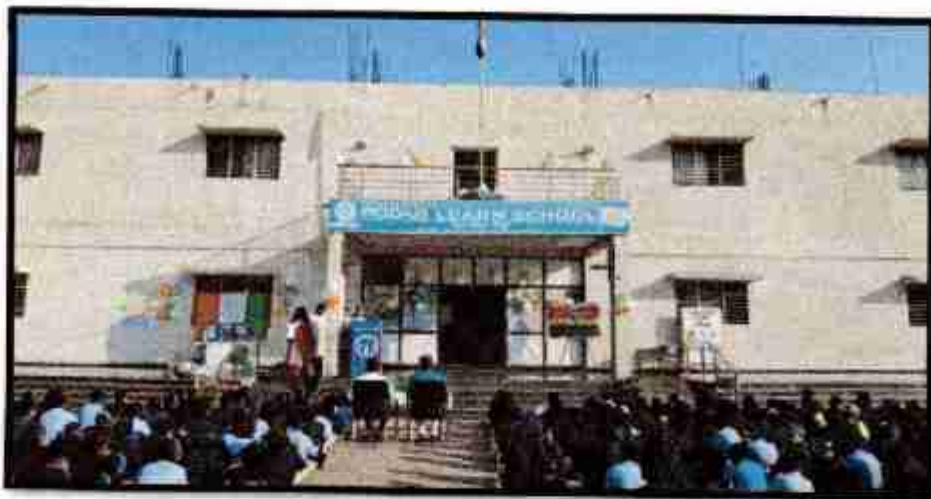
### **"Unfurling the Flag of Unity: Republic Day Celebration"**

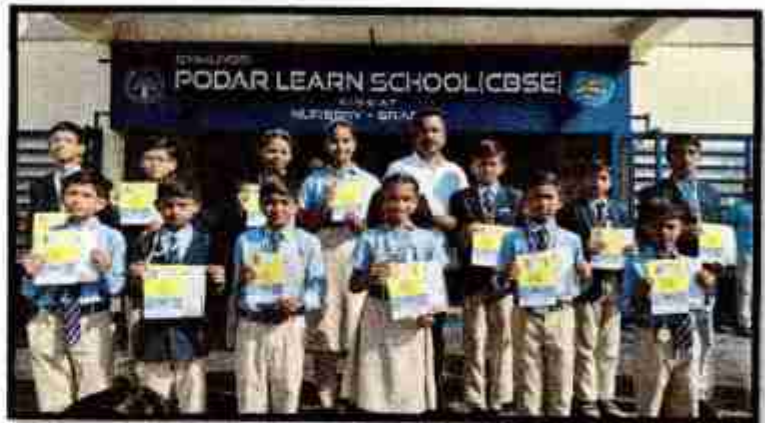
